This Office recommends that discussion with, and advice from, legal counsel be scheduled and heard in closed session, pursuant to California Government Code Section 54956.9(b)(3)(C), regarding proposals for City Council action arising from the report of the Working Group to study the Safer Sex in the Adult Film Industry Ordinance to require condom usage in the adult film industry and to make recommendations regarding amendment of the Ordinance. Government Code Section 54956.9 requires you to state publicly prior to the closed session, what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding the significant exposure to litigation against the public agency.

The second written communication is an email communication to the CAO's office on May 11, 2012, from Allan Gelbard, who described himself as a First Amendment and Intellectual Property lawyer.
