To amend Article 2 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

relating to	o offenses against public order, so as to define certain terms; to provide that a
person co	mmits defamation when he or she causes an unknowing person wrongfully to be
identified	as the person in an obscene depiction; to provide for penalties; to repeal conflicting
laws; and	for other purposes.
	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
	SECTION 1.
Article 2	of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
offenses a	gainst public order, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

(a) As u	used in this Code section, the term:
<u>(1) 'N</u>	udity' means a state of undress so as to expose the human male or female genitals,
pubic	area, or buttocks, with or without a translucent covering, or the showing of the
<u>female</u>	e breasts, with or without a translucent covering, of any portion thereof below the
top of	the nipple.
(2) 'O	bscene depiction' means a visual depiction of an individual displaying nudity or
<u>sexual</u>	conduct.
<u>(3) 'S</u>	exual conduct' means actual or simulated acts of masturbation, homosexuality,
<u>sexual</u>	intercourse, or physical contact in an act of apparent sexual stimulation or
gratifi	cation with a person's clothed or unclothed genitals, pubic area, buttocks, or, if such
person	is female, breasts.
(b) A p	person commits the offense of defamation if such person intentionally causes an
unknow	ing person wrongfully to be identified as the person in an obscene depiction in such
<u>a manne</u>	er that a reasonable person would conclude that the image depicted was that of the
person s	so wrongfully identified. Such identification shall include, without limitation, a

26	person's name, address, telephone number, or e-mail address. Such identification shall also
27	include the electronic imposing of the facial image of a person onto an obscene depiction.
28	(c) Any person convicted of violating subsection (b) of this Code section shall be guilty
29	of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by
30	imprisonment for not more than one year, or both."
